

Meet Leon Reynolds Jr.

"West Dallas is where the RSR Inc. Lead Smelter was, and for 60 years it spewed lead into the atmosphere, where it settled in my town and bound itself to the dirt. Lead poisoning affects IQ scores, being able to pay attention, and I believe it made it hard for me to learn to read."

FAMILY: "I have two brothers and one sister."

PARENTS MARRIED/DIVORCED: "My dad never married my mom."

EDUCATION: "I made it to ninth grade and then I dropped out, mainly because I had a hard time learning to read. I felt like I couldn't continue school because of that, and I felt dumb and embarrassed. In hindsight I should have gotten help. If I got help for my reading I wouldn't be here living shelterless on the street today. By the way, dropping out launched me into all sorts of nefarious endeavors. I ended up going to jail 12 times for burglaries, and then I went to jail for crack cocaine and other drugs."

MILITARY SERVICE: "No."

WHEN MOVED TO LA: "I was living in Texas, and I came out to Palm Springs to visit my mom's sister. That was back in '82. After a while, she said I could stay, but I was a troublemaker, and I bet they regret that decision."

WHERE DO YOU LIVE? "Right here on the street. I'll probably spend the night on the sidewalk over on San Pedro Street."

RELIGION: "I am a Baptist. I believe in God, yes I do."

MEDICATIONS: "I have gout and high blood pressure. I take a lot of Benedryl!"

FAVORITE MOVIE: "I love the Descent series."

FAVORITE TV SHOW: "NCIS."

FAVORITE ACTOR: "Tom Cruise, Leo DiCaprio, Brad Pitt, Matt Damon, Denzel Washington, Jaime Foxx, Will Smith, Sean Connery ... just to name a few."

MOST PRIZED POSSESSION: "My bible. It's what gets me through."

IF YOU HAD \$1 MILLION: "I would get a place to live in and then help others. Mainly, I would help the elderly and kids."

ADVICE FOR EVERYDAY PEOPLE: "Stay in school. Don't stop learning. Don't hate."
