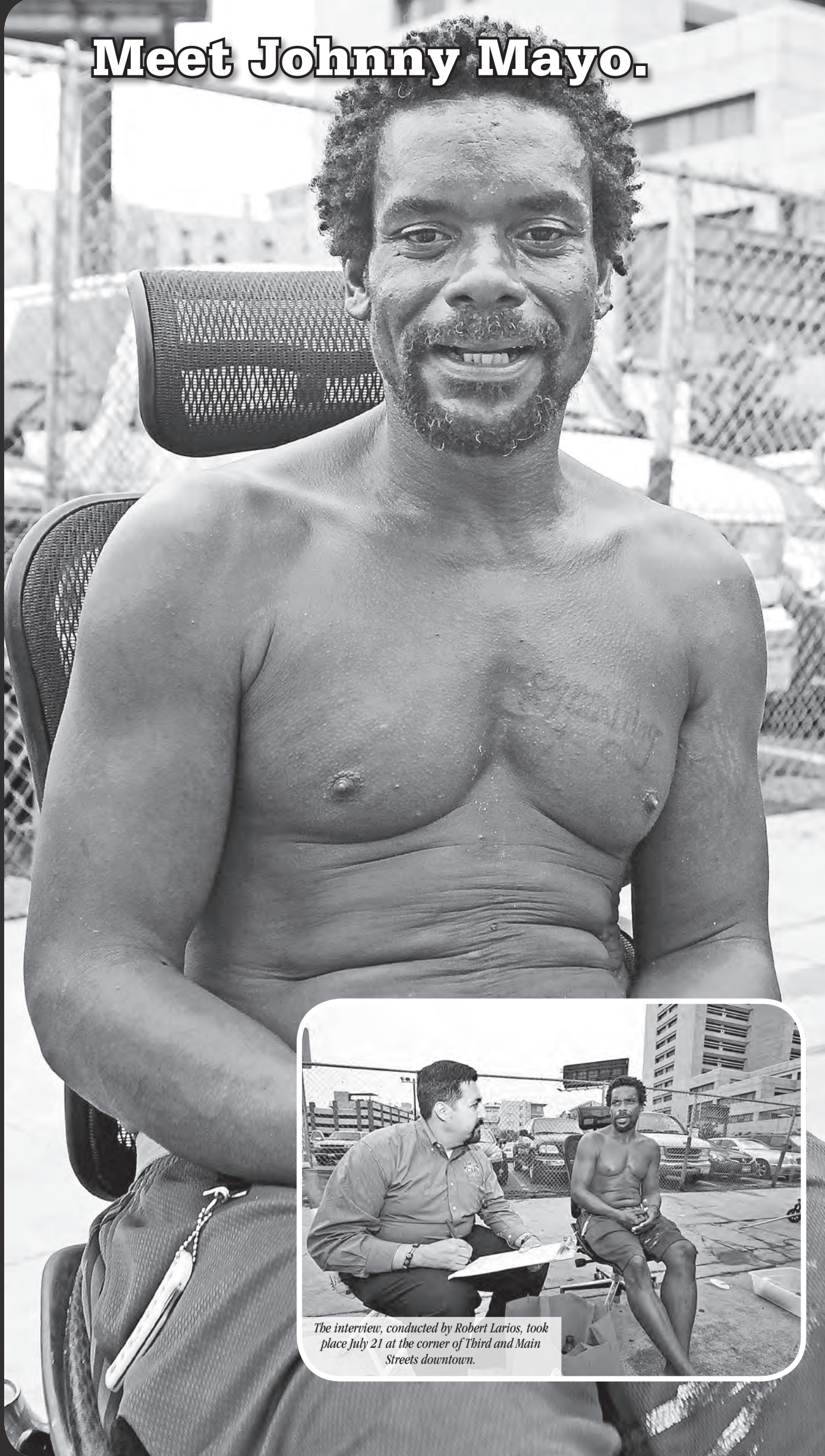

"My girlfriend right over there."

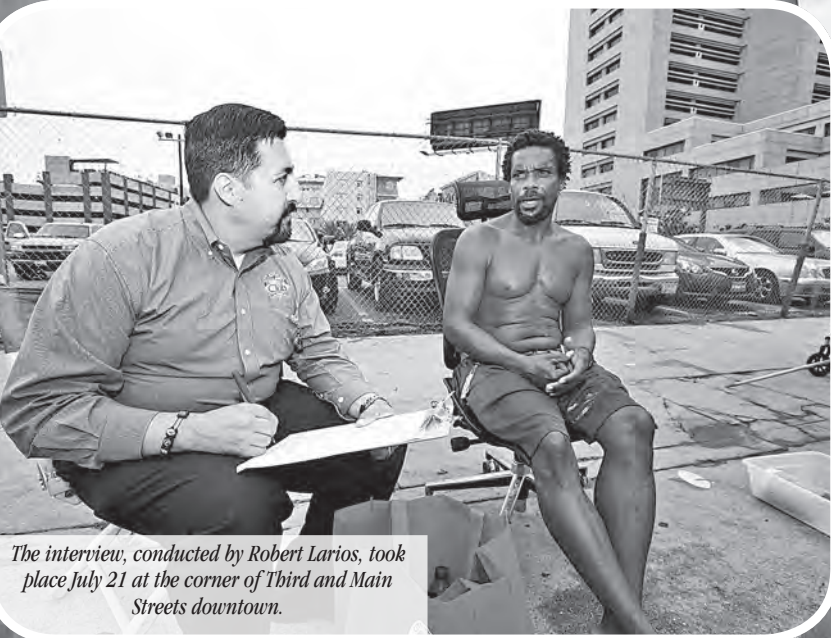
IF YOU WERE MAYOR: "I would set aside a large property for people to live and get off the streets."
