In mid-April, the Club helped celebrate National Dispatchers Week by visiting with as many of the City's dispatchers as we could manage.

The voices of the people on the other end of the 911 calls belong to the Police Service Representatives (PSRs) of the LAPD. And all these fine folks were the focus of the local observance of National Dispatchers Week at the Metropolitan Dispatch Center and the Valley Dispatch Center, which opened last year.

The LAPD Communications Division has approximately more than 650 PSRs. The Metropolitan and Valley centers are the busiest in California. In 2003, the PSRs answered more than 3.3 million calls for service, and the average operator can take anywhere from 150 to 250 calls per shift. They do it without glory or fanfare. But National Dispatchers Week changes that.


