

Summer Jams

■ Pershing Square concert series kicks off.

REC AND PARKS — Pershing Square kicked off its 2005 Summer Concert Series June 7 with a Tribute Tuesday performance by “Dog & Butterfly,” playing the music of the rock band Heart, from noon to 2 p.m. at the downtown outdoor concert and event center.

Additional first Tuesday of the month tribute acts that will play are Cubensis (Grateful Dead), Led Zepagain (Led Zeppelin), and Dr. Wu (Steely Dan). Other artists that will perform during the 40-show series include some of L.A.’s most popu-

lar nightclub bands: 50 Cent Hair Cut, MINIBAR, Eastside All Stars, The Black Tongued Bells, Brasil Brazil, and Soda and His Million Piece Band. Lunchtime concerts are Tuesdays and Thursdays, noon to 2 p.m.

Salsa Sunday is the third Sunday of the month from 3 to 5 p.m. and will offer a different Salsa taste each month, with room for dancing as well. Performers will include Actimba Project (jazz), Timbache (mambo), Omo Olfi (rumba) and Son Cobano (cubana).

For the second year, there will be three Summer Youth Concerts — June 28, July 26 and August 23 — the fourth Tuesday of each month. These kids-oriented events will run from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., with shows at noon and 1 p.m. There will also be inflatable rides, magic, storytelling, and more. Youth artists will include Gregory Scott, B4E Band, Teen Grooves, Cragar the Magician and Hip Hop Harry.

Pershing Square is at 532 S. Olive St., between Fifth and Sixth Streets, in the downtown area, with plenty of shaded eating areas. Food and beverages will be available for purchase at the venue, but guests are also welcome to bring their own and come as a group.
