# Summer lams Pershing Square concert series kicks off.

REC AND PARKS — Pershing Square kicked off its lar nightclub bands: 50 Cent Hair Cut, MINI-2005 Summer Concert Series June 7 with a Tribute Tuesday performance by "Dog & Butterfly," playing the music of the rock band Heart, from noon to 2 p.m. at the downtown outdoor concert and event center.

Additional first Tuesday of the month tribute acts that will play are Cubensis (Grateful Dead), Led Zepagain (Led Zeppelin), and Dr. Wu (Steely Dan). 
