POLICE DEPT. — The world premiere of Donaco Smyth's *Annoyed by Life* opens at the Hudson Guild Theater in Hollywood and runs Sept. 6 to Oct. 12. The zany and intelligent comedy is produced by Dancing Man Productions, which has a history of presenting sketch and improv comedy in New York City. *Annoyed by Life* is the first full-length play that the comedy troupe has taken on.
