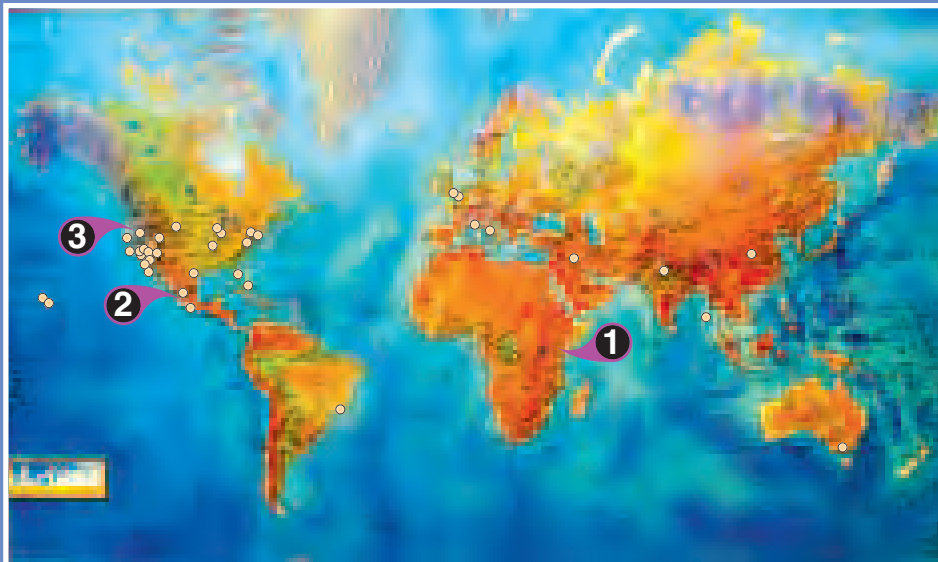
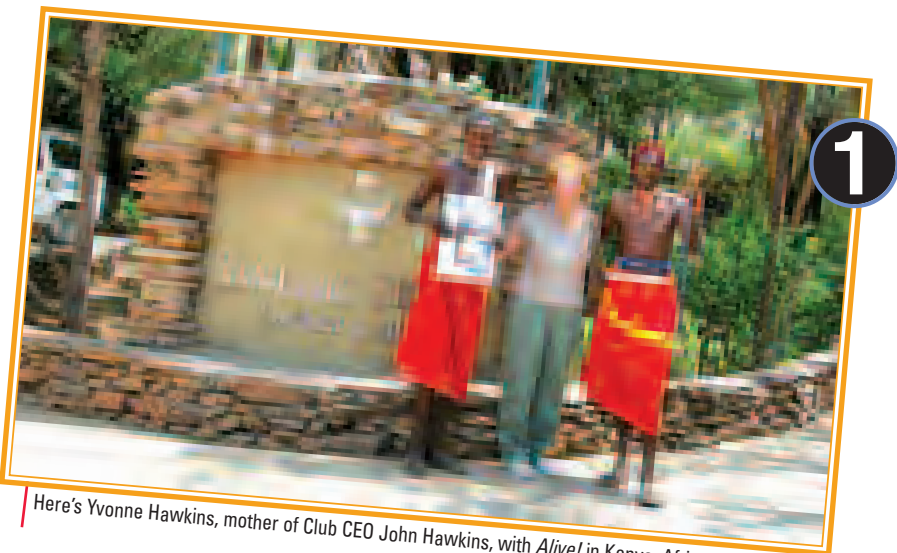


# Alive! Around the World
