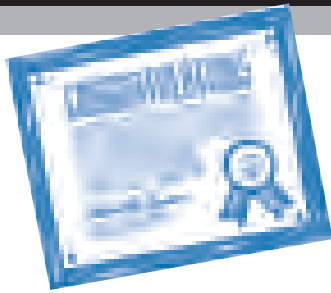


Sanitation Graduation

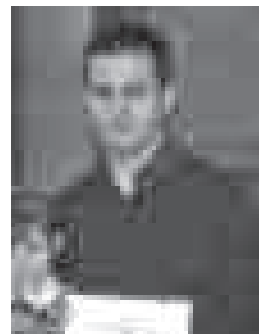
