Christmas trees:

Never purchase a dry Christmas tree.

- Never place a Christmas tree near a fireplace or any other heating source.
- Remove your Christmas tree before it becomes brittle, or no later than Jan. 1.
- Make sure your live Christmas tree has plenty of water.
- Always recycle your Christmas tree; never burn it in the fireplace.

Candles:

- Keep all candles away from flammable materials.
- Always place candles in a good, sturdy holder that won't burn, and won't tip over.

Christmas lights:

- Never use Christmas lights that are broken, have missing lights or have frayed cords.
- Always turn off Christmas lights prior to leaving your house or going to bed at night.

Wrapping paper:

Never throw wrapping paper into a fireplace.

Fireplaces:

- Always use a fireplace screen when using your fireplace.
- Make sure your fireplace has a spark arrestor.

For good safety:

- Make sure you have a working smoke alarm.
- If your clothes catch on fire, know how to "stop" (where you are), "drop" (to the ground) and "roll" (to smother the fire).
- Always dial 9-1-1 to report emergencies.
