Kirk Rises Higher

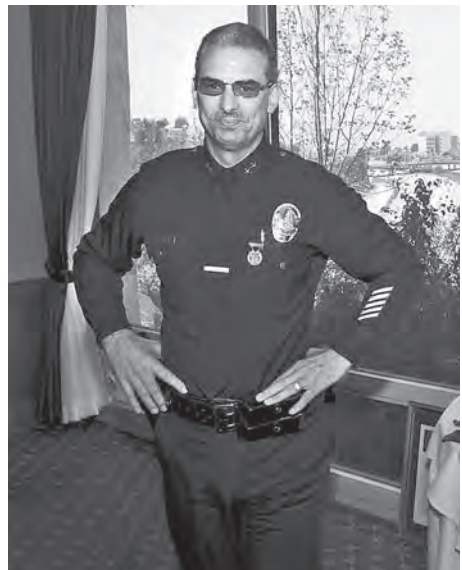
A party honors the promotion of Dep. Chief Kirk Albanese.
