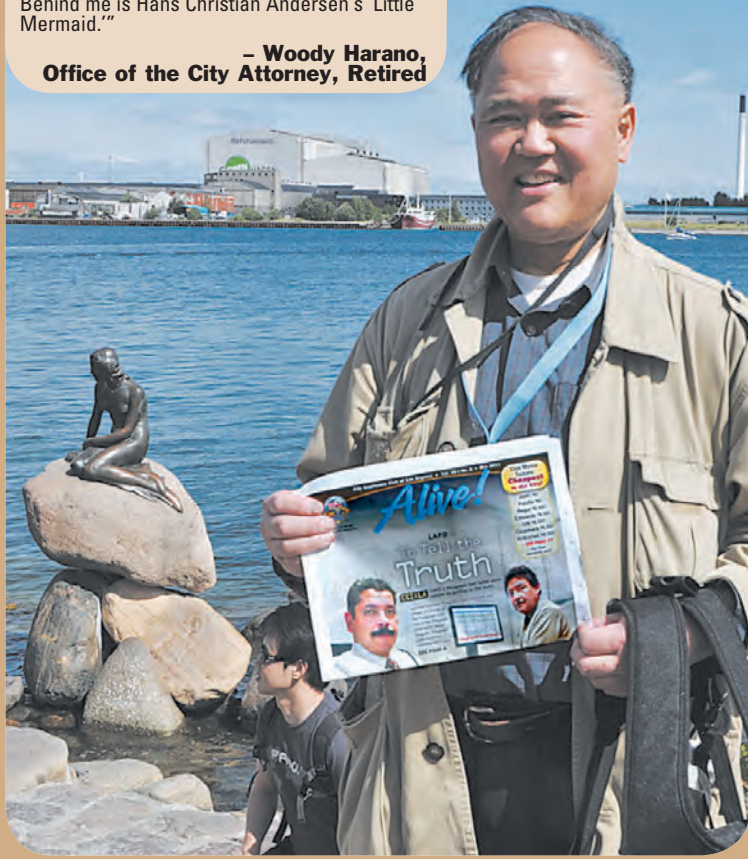

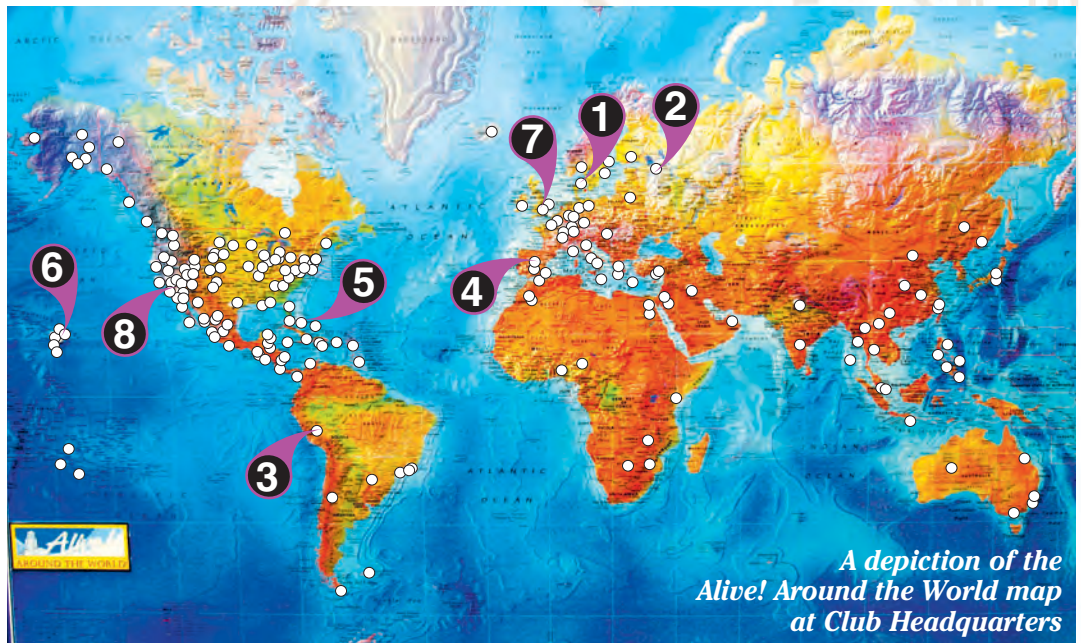

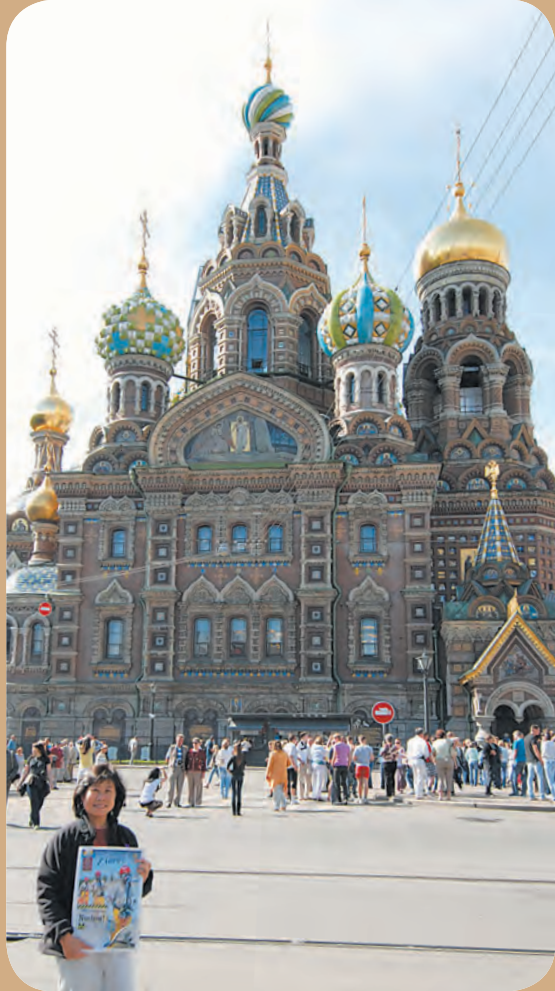
### Sending Digital Photos
