

## With Club Insurance, Long Term Is Better Than Short Term

Why doesn't the Club offer insurance to cover shortterm disability? Because the Club offers a much richer coverage – long-term disability insurance.

In comparison, a short-term disability insurance plan will pay a maximum of only up to two years and typically does not cover on-the-job injuries. With the City Employees Club's group long-term disability insurance (LTD), the policy protects your income until the age of 65 in the event of permanent disability. LTD covers injury or illness, on or off the job, giving you a much more comprehensive coverage than a short-term disability policy would. While both disability plans pay out a monthly benefit, with short-term disability you must choose a set amount of benefit. With our LTD, the benefit payout is a percentage of 60 to 70 percent of your current income tax-free, essentially what your takehome pay is after taxes.


Simply ask yourself, if you currently do not have the Club's long-term disability plan, in the event you got hurt or sick, is your income enough for you to sustain your lifestyle?

Also, you don't have to use all your vacation time for the Club's long-term disability plan to pay. In fact we encourage you to not use your vacation time. Remember, as a City or

DWP employee, you are no longer contributing to the State Disability Insurance (SDI). Therefore you may not be able to file a claim for SDI.

Lesley Jennifer Cornejo, LAFD, is graduating from the University of La Verne in organizational management.


