Welcome, RLACEI Members!

As your Retirement Benefits Counselor, I welcome with great pleasure our new RLACEI retirees to the City Employees Club! I've had the opportunity to speak to some of you, and I hope for the chance to hear from more of you. We have a team of benefit counselors here at the Club to clarify all of our insurance benefits we offer. Although we have a wide array of benefits, the most popular insurance programs amongst our retirees are long-term care, life insurance, identity theft protection, and family legal services.

Long term care insurance (LTCi) will protect your assets and pension against loss in the event of needing and affording custodial care. Our group LTCi is offered through Unum, one of the top five nationwide insurance carriers for LTCi. Our group plan is eligible to Club members who have retired from the City, active employees, and spouses, in addition to parents and in-laws. The plan is designed to pay out a monthly benefit directly to the insured to cover

the costs of nursing facility expenses or custodial in-home care.

Life insurance is provided to protect your loved ones who depend on your income and cover last minute or burial costs. We offer a group term retiree life insurance to our members, spouses, and dependent children. If you are already on our life insurance plan and have retired, you are still eligible to participate as a recipient of our annual refund check. Feel free to ask me how that works.

One of our more recent plans is Privacy Armor, which offers ID theft protection against fraudulent activity of your identity. This includes but is not limited to the misuse of your Social Security number, credit history, and name. The plan acts as a monitoring service and will go as far as writing letters on your behalf to excuse you from illegal activity. Identity theft protection is also provided to your immediate family – spouse and dependent children.

Last but not least is our family legal plan, which

provides consultative legal services at a discount from a wide network of licensed attorneys nationwide. One of the benefits of this plan I like most is drawing up a simple living will for no additional charge by being a member of the plan. Your spouse, dependent children and parents, whether or not they live with you, also have access to legal services with your membership.
