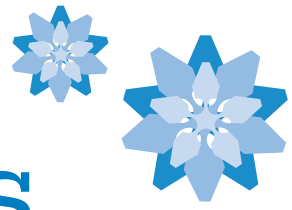

DWP Open Enrollment This Month

If you are an active DWP employee, it is very important to review your Club benefits this month to prepare for Open Enrollment this April.

One of the ways you can do this is to stop by the Club store or call us to verify your coverage. It is important to familiarize yourself with your deductions and what those acronyms represent on your pay stub. For example, if you have insurance with the City Employees Club, you will see a deduction code of "LACEA 41." You are always welcome to contact us for

clarification of your benefits and request a statement. The benefit statement will include a breakdown of your type of benefit coverage and monthly premiums. It is generally a good idea to do this as often as you receive a pay stub or at minimum, the weeks prior to your Open Enrollment so you can make changes with the City/DWP.

Has your family size changed? Have you purchased a home? Do you have enough coverage to leave a legacy for your family, loved ones, or those who depend on your income?

As a general overview of the insurance offered by the Club, we offer voluntary and ancillary insurance for you and, on most of our plans, your spouse and children are eligible, too. Here's a snapshot of benefits we offer:

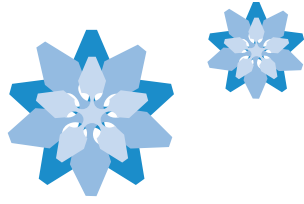
