Harlyne Norris has done so much for the Banning Museum over the years, and museum leadership recognized her contributions and support.

In celebration of the 150th Anniversary of the Banning Mansion, guests experienced the elegance and graciousness of a formal Victorian-era gala with a sumptuous dinner, hosted bar, enchanting music, period dancers and a silent auction. Keeping with tradition, the event also crowned the King and Queen of Wisteria and presented two high school seniors with a \$2,000 scholarship to further their education after graduating Banning High School.
